



John Forte has been diagnosed with PTSD due to symptoms that are a direct result of duty-related matters, specifically, the JPD police action on 8/25/09. Because he is hyper-vigilant, i.e. super sensitive to noise or movement, suspicious, fearful, and subject to mistakenly hearing live ammunition being fired, this officer should not carry a weapon or be required to make decisions about deadly force. At this time there is no evidence that this condition would change or improve.

John Forte has been diagnosed with PTSD due to symptoms that are a direct result of duty-related matters, specifically, the JPD police action on 8/25/09.

Following the initial diagnosis on 4/23/09, when Mr. Forte was prescribed the medications Remeron and Lunesta, he has only been seen by me for medication management. Dr. Harris provides continued psychological therapy.

In my professional opinion, Mr. Forte is not presently capable of working in a setting that requires quick assessments of a situation and decisions about the use of deadly force at this time. The severity of his symptoms at this time indicate that he is unlikely to be able to return to active police officer employment in the foreseeable future.
