

Maumelle Police Department**Press Release****5/21/12****For Immediate Release:**

On 5/18/12 at approximately 9:24 P.m. Maumelle Police responded to a call for service at America's Best Value hotel located at 14325 Frontler Drive in Maumelle. This call related to a reported disturbance between a male and a female. Upon arrival the officers made contact with a 27 year old black female who reported and showed signs of an injured ankle. The ensuing investigation resulted in the arrest of the female for Possession of a Controlled Substance. The female claimed that she sustained the injury to her ankle during a verbal altercation with Jermalne Taylor. She alleged that she had arrived at the hotel for the purpose of having sex with Taylor in exchange for money and that they began arguing. She alleged that she had become frightened during this argument, fled the hotel room, and in doing so had fallen down a flight of stairs which resulted in an injury to her ankle. She was later transported to Baptist Medical Center to treat the injury. Once at the hospital, she claimed that she was raped by Mr. Taylor.

The investigation regarding the night of the 18th is ongoing.

Upon my arrival I made contact with _____ who stated that she had an argument with the male subject she was with, Mr. Jermain Taylor, and she fell down the stairs as she was trying to get away. I observed that _____ ankle was swollen and she had sustained scrapes on that ankle, that were bleeding. _____ refused treatment at the scene. Sergeant Ivey, Corporal Bryant and I spoke with _____ who stated that she drove from Mississippi with two of her friends, April and Asia and were paid \$500.00 plus gas money for oral sex with Mr. Taylor. _____ stated that she had been coming up here weekly to meet with Mr. Taylor and that the last time she was here he had paid her \$2000.00. _____ stated that when she got hurt Mr. Taylor left the scene, as did April and Asia. Officers observed that _____ seemed confused and disoriented. _____ admitted to using marijuana. Officers were given consent to search her motel room #214, where we found 16 Lortab tablets with the imprint "Watson 540" in an unmarked pill bottle. _____ admitted to taking one of them about 45 minutes prior to our arrival. I observed a strong odor of marijuana in the room. _____ was arrested and brought to the department in my vehicle #73 for processing. Once at the department _____ requested MEMS to come and check out her injury. MEMS checked her injury and Ms. _____ declined to go to the hospital. _____ was mirandized and agreed to talk with officers. _____ was charged with possession of controlled substance and a \$5000.00 bond was set per city prosecutor JaNan Davis. All evidence was brought to the department and placed in an evidence locker. _____ was taken to the Pulaski County Jail where they refused to take her due to her injury. On 5/18/12, Corporal Bryant, Officer Robinson, and I were dispatched to the America's Best Value Motel in response to a disturbance that had already occurred. Upon arrival, we spoke with [redacted] who stated that she had been in an argument with Jermain Taylor. [redacted] stated that she drove from Mississippi to meet Taylor who she has known since 2006. [redacted] stated that Taylor was going to pay her \$2000.00 for sexual relations. [redacted] stated that she and Taylor smoked marijuana together in room 214, and an argument ensued. [redacted] said that she then exited the motel room and began to run down the stairs. [redacted] said that she then fell down the stairs causing injury to her left ankle. [redacted] appeared to be intoxicated due to smoking marijuana, and she was somewhat disoriented. Officers went to room 214 to see if Taylor was still in the room, but there was no one else inside. Officers could detect a strong odor of marijuana coming from the room. [redacted] consented to allowing officers search the motel room which produced an unlabeled prescription bottle containing 16 Lortab pills. [redacted] was arrested for possession of controlled substance (reference 12-407-AR). Officers spoke to the manager of the motel, Patel, who confirmed that Taylor had been at the motel with [redacted]. Patel also stated that Taylor had left the motel prior to officers arrival. [redacted] could not locate the keys to her vehicle, a Cadillac, which was parked in the back parking lot of the motel. [redacted] informed officers that she threw the keys during the argument. It was also noted that [redacted] cell phone was shattered. [redacted] was brought to the police department, and she was read her miranda rights. [redacted] was also treated by the Maumelle Fire Department, but she refused to be transported to the hospital. [redacted] informed Officer Robinson and me that Taylor had given \$500.00 to her so she would perform oral sex on him. [redacted] stated that she did perform oral sex on Taylor before the argument occurred. [redacted] did have \$500 in cash in her possession (5, \$100 bills). [redacted] was transported to the Pulaski County Jail by Officer Robinson. The Pulaski County Jail refused to take her into custody due to the injuries on her ankle. Officer Robinson then transported [redacted] to the Baptist Hospital in Little Rock. During this time, [redacted] informed Officer Robinson that she believed that she was drugged and did not remember what occurred throughout the evening. [redacted] was advised to contact CID if she wished to provide further statements as to the incident. [redacted] was cited out on the charge of possession of a controlled substance per the prosecuting attorney, Janan Davis. [redacted] was given a court date of 5/22/12 at 1600 hours. On 5/19/12 at approximately 0630 hours, I was contacted by the emergency room at Baptist Hospital. I was informed that [redacted] stated that she had been raped by Taylor. Baptist Hospital performed a rape kit on [redacted] which was collected by Officer Hicks. The rape kit was placed into an evidence locker at the police department. Baptist Hospital also informed officers that [redacted] had a broken left ankle. [redacted] was told to contact CID to provide a statement. Lieutenant Hansard and Corporal Giompoletti were notified of the situation. There is no further information at this time. ---Sergeant Dustin Ivey #573.
