

CITY'S RESORTS WILL BE CLOSED UP AUGUST 25TH

Tolerance to Cease in Accordance With Vice Commission's Recommendations.

ANNOUNCEMENT BY MAYOR

Report Declares Social Evil is Proportionately as Bad in Little Rock as Elsewhere.

MONTHLY FINES ABOLISHED

Tolerance of immoral resorts in Little Rock's segregated red light district will cease three months from today. This positive announcement was made last night by Mayor Chas. E. Taylor, as a result of sweeping revelations and recommendations contained in the report of the Little Rock Vice Commission, made public yesterday.

Preliminary to the municipal war on protected vice, to be conducted after August 25, Mayor Taylor declared the practice of collecting monthly fines from women of the underworld will be stopped at once. This action will result in a monthly revenue loss of \$300 to the city.

The city of the municipality's intention to close all immoral houses three months from today will be served offensively to the women of the underworld. All resort inmates will be given an opportunity to leave Little Rock before August 25, and those who remain here in defiance of the city's warning must lead straightforward lives or suffer the consequences, the mayor said.

The Vice Commission's report to Mayor Taylor is the result of a year's investigation into every phase of the social evil as it exists in Little Rock. It shows extraordinary prevalence in a proportionately degree to vice in the largest cities in the nation.

In advocating the suppression of tolerated vice in Little Rock, the commission recommended that the city should close all houses in operation be closed August 25 and compelled to remain closed.

That city ordinances against the sale of liquor in immoral resorts be enforced at once.

That the practice of collecting monthly fines from women of the underworld be abolished immediately.

That owners of property used as immoral resorts be held liable for the same.

That a better lighting system be established in the parks of Little Rock as a means of ending clandestine prostitution.

That the city pass an ordinance requiring all persons admitted to the parks to give their true names at police headquarters, under penalty of a fine.

That the state legislature enact laws in support of city ordinances and particularly laws dealing with white slavery.

That the city create a board with special jurisdiction over the suppression of the social evil.

That three special police officers, one woman, be appointed to patrol the streets and report improper action thereon by young boys and girls.

That city officials take steps to prevent grafting on the part of police officials and others in dealing with women of the underworld.

The Vice Commission's report shows there are 19 houses of prostitution in the city, the majority of which are conducted by white women inmates, within Little Rock's segregated red light district, on the east by Rock street, on the south by Third street, and on the west by Main street.

The commission shows there are 75 white women inmates of resorts, ranging in age from 16 to 45 years, with an average of 25 years old. It is estimated by the commission, however, that Little Rock has no less than 600 immoral women who earn their livelihood by prostitution.

In questioning women inmates of the houses of prostitution, the commission found a majority of women reach their condition in life through a desire for money or through the perjury of man.

The commission found the percentage of clandestine prostitution to be high in Little Rock, as in other cities, and that this condition is one of the most difficult problems with which police officials will have to deal.

Disease resulting from the operation of protected houses of prostitution was found to be widespread in Little Rock, regardless of the fact that the sanitation in the immoral houses is as good here as elsewhere.

Report of Negro Commission.

The Negro Vice Commission reported to Mayor Taylor it had been unable to find licensed houses of prostitution in the Negro quarter, but cited Negro pool halls as evil dens of vice. Many Negro resorting houses were found to be of questionable character.

It was reported by the negro commission that collectors of the tax on taking advantage of negro women

120 PASSENGERS DROWN

Turkish Vessel Flying American Flag Sunk by War Mines.

Sydney, May 24.—The steamer Narda, with 120 passengers on board, struck three mines in the Aegean sea, and sank. Only 40 passengers were saved. The mines were strewn in the coast waters by the Turks to prevent attack by the Greek fleet during the Balkan war.

SPECTATORS PLUNGE TO THEIR DEATHS

53 Killed, Principally Women, When Long Beach Auditorium Pier Collapses.

INJURED MAY TOTAL FIFTY

Victims Were Attending Celebration of Birthday of Queen Victoria—Most Were Trampled by Survivors.

Long Beach, Cal., May 24.—Two weeks to uphold the burden of nearly 10,000 human beings assembled for the festivities of "British Empire Day," the land end of the big double-decked ship, the Victoria, which was the city and auditorium collapsed today. Hundreds of persons on the top deck were plunged down on the heads of other people who crowded on the second deck. The deck then gave way, and all were dropped down a chute of shattered woodwork to the tide-washed sands, 25 feet below.

Fifty-three persons—mostly women—were killed by the shivered timbered and crushed to death by the falling bodies of companions and friends. Fifty more were seriously injured, while hysteria and fright caused the disabling of scores of others.

A section of the auditorium which had fallen in the crash and the wreckage from it was added to the wreckage that fell upon the injured and dead.

The victims included the former subjects of Great Britain, resident in southern California.
