Forster notified Fuehrer Hitler of his action, by telegram. Article one of Forster's decree suspended the constitution of the Free City immediately. Under the city's League of Nations status its constitution was guaranteed

constitution was guaranteed by the League, and changes without its consent were de-clared illegal. Article two of the decree placed all legal and admin-istrative power exclusively in the hands of the chief of state,
